Attendants Recommended: 1 adult

General Rules To Follow During Use Of Unit:

1. All persons must remove shoes and wear protective headgear (provided) before entering the arena.
2. Participantss safety depends on you. Control over exuberance and showoffs. Inflate The Fun inflatables are top quality, well engineered products designed for the pleasure and safety of contestantss. Use it wisely.
3. To avoid back injuries, flips are not allowed!
4. Absolutely no silly string, gum candy, food, or other foreign substances are allowed in, on or around the unit.
5. No more than two contestants at a time. Make sure both have exited before allowing another two on the unit.
6. Attendant monitors contestants at entrance. It is best for the attendant to be on the ground fitting the next two players headgear. This way you can see the entire arena.
7. Do not allow those in line to hang or lay on the side of the walls of the Arena!
8. Make sure contestants are firmly on pedestal before match begins. Allow contestants 2-3 combat matches before next group comes on (usually 2 minutes at most).
9. No hitting a fellow contestant while he/she is not looking or is laying on the floor of the arena. **NO STRAIGHT FACE JABBING!!**

Problems: Should your jump begin to deflate:

1. Motor has stopped. Check cord to connection at outlet and on motor itself. Check circuit breakers. Remember, only one 50-foot cord and nothing else on that outlet. Stronger outlets are in the kitchen, laundry room, and garage.
2. Motor still running. Check air intake on side of motor for blockage, check the tube on back of unit for snugness and retie if necessary.
3. In the event of excessive wind (20 miles per hour or greater) or rain, evacuate sports cage and deflate unit until poor weather has subsided.
4. A cleaning fee of no less than \$ 75.00 will be charged to client if unit is not returned in the same condition as in which it was dropped off. Client will be responsible for any damage incurred due to rough play or misuse of unit.
