



## *Slip N Slide Waterslide*

*Attendants Recommended: 1 adult*

### **General Rules To Follow During Use Of Unit:**

1. All persons must remove shoes, socks and should have on swimsuits (for optimal experience) before playing on unit. (No belts, chains, or any other item that may puncture the unit).
2. Participant's safety depends on you. Control over exuberance and showoffs. Inflate The Fun inflatables are top quality, well engineered products designed for the pleasure and safety of contestants. Use it wisely.
3. To avoid back injuries, flips are not allowed!
4. Absolutely no silly string, gum candy, food, or other foreign substances are allowed in, on or around the unit.
5. No more than two contestants at a time (one on each lane). Make sure both have exited before allowing another two on the unit. (Unless it is Single Lane Slip n slide then only 1 contestant at a time).
6. Attendant monitors contestants at entrance. Approximately 20-30 feet in front of sliding lanes.
7. Have riders form a single file line before entering slide (or a 2 person line if using Double Lane).

### **Problems: Should your jump begin to deflate:**

1. Motor has stopped. Check cord to connection at outlet and on motor itself. Check circuit breakers. Remember, only one 50-foot cord and nothing else on that outlet. Stronger outlets are in the kitchen, laundry room, and garage. **MAKE SURE WATER IS NOT COMING INTO CONTACT WITH ELECTRICAL BLOWER OR ELECTRICAL CORDS.** Electric shock can occur!
2. Motor still running. Check air intake on side of motor for blockage, check the tube on back of unit for snugness and retie if necessary.
3. In the event of deflation, calmly evacuate unit.
4. If the unit is not on solid, flat ground it can slide downhill. It is important to stake corners to prevent downhill movement. If an area begins to saturate with water and creates excessive mud, you may wish to move the unit to another area of the lawn.
5. This unit does not require much water, therefore do not place spray on high pressure. Also a strategically placed unit near a drain helps a great deal as well.
6. A cleaning fee of no less than \$ 75.00 will be charged to client if unit is not returned in the same condition as in which it was dropped off. Client will be responsible for any damage incurred due to rough play or misuse of unit.
